### **Parent or Guardian Covenant**

1. I am enclosing a deposit: **\$175 per week of Resident Camp; \$90 per week of Day Camp**. The deposit includes a **non-refundable** \$75 processing fee (per week). The deposit amount is applied to the total tuition.
2. I will pay the remaining balance of **Resident Camp fees on or before May 1**. If applying after May 1, I will pay Resident Camp fees in full at the time of registration. I will pay the remaining balance of **Day Camp fees on or before the start of the day camp week**.
3. In the event of cancellation prior to May 1, Chestnut Ridge will refund all fees paid **less** the \$75 processing fee per week of camp.
4. In the event of cancellation after May 1, **no fees shall be refunded**.
5. I will present a completed **Health History Form** at check-in on the first day my child attends Summer Camp. I understand my camper will not be allowed to stay at camp without a completed Health History form on site.
6. In the event of an emergency in which the parent(s) cannot be contacted, emergency medical staff and Chestnut Ridge staff may take appropriate action in the best interest of my child.
7. I give permission for Chestnut Ridge to use pictures of my child as a program participant in promotional literature, promotional videos and on the camp website. I understand my child's photo or likeness may appear in news media. At no time will my child's full name be published or broadcast.
8. Chestnut Ridge is not responsible for articles of clothing or personal belongings lost, damaged, or left at camp.
9. I understand that Chestnut Ridge offers some activities that could put my child at physical risk including but not limited to high ropes, zipline, horseback riding, archery, slingshots, caving, rock climbing, white water rafting, camping, backpacking, swimming, mountain biking, canoeing, inflatable lake toys, and campfires. If eligible, I allow my child to participate in such activities and I release Chestnut Ridge from responsibility for injuries or illnesses, which my child may sustain from participation in these activities, or if I do not want my child to participate, I will alert the camp in writing.
10. I give consent for my child to leave camp to participate in authorized camp trips and be transported in Chestnut Ridge vehicles.
11. I understand that Chestnut Ridge assumes no responsibility for injuries or illnesses which my child may sustain as a result of his/her physical condition or resulting from his/her participation in camp activities. In consideration of the privilege of participating at camp, I hereby voluntarily release and discharge Chestnut Ridge, its agents, contract services, servants, and employees from any and all claims for injury, illness, death, loss or damage which my child may suffer as a result of his/her participation in camp activities.
12. While Chestnut Ridge will make every attempt to provide reasonable accommodations for every applicant, the camp reserves the right to decline the application of, or send home, any child who, according to the Director's discretion, is detrimental to the general welfare of camp and other campers. I understand that in such a situation, tuition is NOT refundable.
13. I will make every effort to attend the Parent Tea at 3:30pm on Sunday the first week of our family's attendance at camp. The Parent Tea happens every Sunday during summer camp except August 12<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>.
